The Labelling of Food Order, 1946


1. I am directed by the Minister of Food to send for the information of the Authority, a copy of S.I. 1948 No. 2598 (Amendment No. 4 to the Labelling of Food Order S.R. & O. 1946, No. 2169) which permits the sale of soft drinks labelled S.D.I. by wholesalers until 1st March, 1949, and by retailers until 1st June, 1949, free from the requirements of the Order.

2. The Order, which has been made to enable wholesalers and retailers to dispose of accumulated stocks of S.D.I. labelled soft drinks, does not apply to delivery pursuant to sales by manufacturers, packers and labellers.

3. A copy of this Circular and a copy of the enclosure are being sent to the Medical Officer of Health and a spare copy is enclosed for the Sanitary Inspector or Sampling Officer. Further copies may be obtained from H.M. Stationery Office at the addresses shown hereon.
